The Hong Kong Research Institute of Textiles and Apparel opened its showroom today to showcase a series of commercialised deliverables that are ready for industry application. After six years of endeavour, HKRITA has developed various technologies which enhance the competitiveness of the textiles and apparel industry amid the fierce competition around the globe. Currently, we have 45 completed projects and 28 on-going projects. Among them, seven projects have been granted with eight IPs and 30 projects filed with 50 pending IPs. These technological achievements are the result of concerted effort among our long-term research as well as industry partners, and HKRITA.

The deliverables are now displaying in the showroom including garment and yarn samples of Nu-Torque™ cotton yarn production technology, high-performance running and cycling wear tailored made for elite athletes in Hong Kong, knitwear samples treated by shape memory materials production and finishing technology, denim wear finished by electrolytic ozone spray finishing system. Video programmes are also available for demonstrating the application of specific technologies.

In the year ahead, HKRITA will join hands with our research partners to initiate more research projects with significant market potential, such as the new version of high-performance sportswear and environmentally friendly manufacturing. The exhibits in the showroom will be updated regularly. We welcome interested parties to visit us by appointment.
