# Advanced Diploma of Bra Cup Moulding Technology

## 11 February – 21 April 2012 (Every SAT)

Moulding is an essential process for making a moulded bra of both padded and non-padded styles. In current industrial practice, trial and error approach has long been adopted to design and develop the mould prototype based on technicians and engineers' experience. This traditional approach causes material wastage, long lingerie development cycle and high development cost due to repeated iterations in making and re-making proper prototypes. It will also increase the production cost.

For the sake of helping the local technicians, engineers and manufacturers to acquire the relevant moulding theory and knowledge to enhance their existing moulding process, Hong Kong Productivity Council (HKPC) is going to organize the course "Advanced Diploma of Lingerie Moulding Technology" including a 1-day workshop, from 11 February to 21 April 2012.

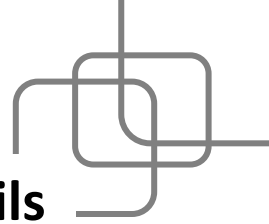

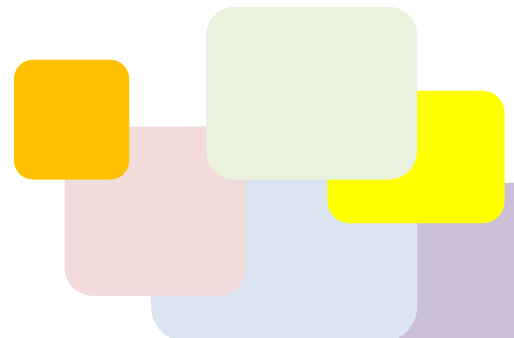

In 2005, Ms Cheung has been the instructor of bra cup molding courses by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University and an overseas 7-day course in Sri Lanka.
